## Purpose of the IRP

Planning Tool, Not Resource Acquisition Proceeding

### IRP Rules, Section 1

- "Each Utility IRP is intended to serve as a general resource forum for the approval of the acquisition, implementation, or planning tool to the Utility and the Council, rather than a deactivation of any supply-side or demand-side resource."
- Council Resolution R-17-332
- and not a vehicle for the consideration of specific assets" ... an IRP process should be a broad analytical framework
- be considered on a case-by-case basis" "... proposals to acquire specific assets should continue to



# Advisor and Stakeholder Input is Important

- Performs Detailed Modeling on an Hour by Hour Basis Which Requires Forecasts on an Hourly Basis and The Development of the IRP Requires Complex Software
- The Output of Detailed Modeling is of Little or No Value if the Inputs to the Model are Inappropriate
- Garbage In / Garbage Out
- Developing Inputs to the IRP Modeling is Critical
- Opinions on Inputs May Differ Due to Perspective
- Specific Inputs Need Not Predict the Future, However the the Future Array of Inputs Should Reasonably be Expected to Encompass
