The Greater New Orleans Housing Alliance, (“GNOHA”) respectfully requests that the Council of the City of New Orleans (“the Council”) grant GNOHA the right to intervene in the above captioned docket and participate as a party therein.

On August 10, 2017, the full Council for the City of New Orleans issued Resolution R-17-430, setting a procedural schedule for this docket, setting a deadline of intervention by October 6, 2017. This request is being made within the intervention period and is therefore timely.

GNOHA is a membership collaborative organization of non-profit housing builders and community development corporations building and re-building affordable housing for the residents of the Greater New Orleans area in an ethical and efficient manner.

GNOHA is a formal intervenor in Council Dockets UD-08-02 and has members served by ENO. There is no other party representing the interests of the GNOHA and its members.

GNOHA’s interest in this proceeding include, but are not limited to, ensuring energy efficiency and other demand side management programs are available to improve the overall housing costs and conditions for all residential customers of Entergy New Orleans, Inc, including residents of affordable and multifamily housing.

GNOHA possesses standing to intervene in the aforementioned matter, and respectfully seeks full intervenor status in order to fully participate in this docket. GNOHA requests that it be placed on the service list of this proceeding and be served with all pleadings, notices orders, and other filings.

Please note that GNOHA is a public advocacy non-profit organization, thus pursuant to resolution R-16-365, we request that all intervenor fees be waived.


