ORDER

On April 30, 2018, Entergy New Orleans, LLC (“ENO”) filed a Motion to Extend All Procedural Schedule Dates by 30 Days.

Considering ENO’s motion and the fact that the City of New Orleans, the Council Advisors, the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, the Alliance for Affordable Energy, the Maple Area Residents, Inc., and the Carrollton River Neighborhood Association have indicated their non-opposition to the requested extension of the procedural schedule dates and no party has opposed the request, IT IS ORDERED that ENO’s Motion to Extend All Procedural Schedule Dates by 30 Days be, and hereby is, GRANTED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all procedural schedule dates established by Council Resolution R-18-98 are hereby extended by 30 days, such that the new procedural schedule will be as shown below:
