**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO
EXTEND DATES IN PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The Advisors to the Council of the City of New Orleans (“Council”), through undersigned counsel, respectfully submits this Unopposed Motion to Extend Dates in Procedural Schedule in the above captioned docket. On October 31, 2018, the Council adopted Resolution R-18-475 initiating a prudence investigation regarding Entergy New Orleans, LLC’s (“ENO”) electric service disruptions and complaints. The resolution directed ENO to make a filing on January 10, 2019 consisting of testimony, evaluations, analyses, workpapers, and other information the Company believed would be of assistance to the Council in the investigation. ENO made its filing on January 10, 2019.

Since that time, many of the parties to this proceeding, including ENO, the Council’s Advisors and some Intervenors have been engaged in extensive and protracted proceedings involving the New Orleans Power Station and, therefore, the Advisors respectfully request a limited extension of the existing dates in the procedural schedule outlined in Resolution R-18-

475. ENO has no opposition to this extension. Mover proposes that the dates be extended by roughly thirty (30) days to provide additional time for the remaining filings to be made in the docket.

Accordingly, the Advisors propose that the schedule be modified as follows:
