# <u>UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME</u>

Entergy New Orleans, LLC ("ENO") respectfully submits this Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time in the above-captioned Docket. ENO respectfully requests that the deadline for filing a Proposed Interim solution, described more fully herein, be extended until April 10, 2019.

1.

On June 21, 2018, in Resolution No. R-18-225, the Council, subsequent to discussions with the Mayor's Office of Resiliency, "opened this rulemaking docket to consider the issue of whether aggregated whole-building data could be released to building owners where a building has four or more meters and also sought comment on any feasibility or logistical issues associated with aggregating and releasing such data to building owners[.]" Resolution R-18-225 also set forth various obligations of the parties and procedural deadlines.

2.

Resolution R-18-225 also appointed the Honorable Jeffrey Gulin as the Hearing Officer in this Docket and vested Judge Gulin with the authority to "change or amend the procedural dates" set forth in the Docket.

The parties to this Docket are ENO, the Advisors ("Advisors") for the Council for the City of New Orleans ("Council"), the Alliance for Affordable Energy, National Housing Trust, the Greater New Orleans Housing Alliance, and the Natural Resource Defense Council (collectively the "Parties").

4.

Following the completion of the procedural steps set forth in Resolution R-18-225, the Council adopted Council Resolution No. 18-539, which set forth additional procedural steps and requirements of the Parties.

5.

At Ordering Paragraph 6, Resolution R-18-539 required that within 90 days of the adoption of the Resolution (on or before March 20, 2019) "any party may file a proposed interim solution for the Council's review and consideration."

6.

On March 18, 2019, ENO circulated a Draft Settlement Term Sheet intended to memorialize a settlement among the Parties as to an agreed upon interim solution. Had the Parties been able to review and execute that Term Sheet on or before March 20, 2019, ENO intended to file the executed Term Sheet in fulfillment of the requirement of Ordering Paragraph 6 described above. However, some of the Parties have requested more time to review the Term Sheet.

7.

On March 25, 2019, the Hearing Officer extended the deadline for filing a Proposed Interim Solution by two weeks, until April 3, 2019.

8.

At present, ENO continues to work with the Parties to achieve consensus on the language of the Term Sheet. As such, ENO respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer further extend the deadline for filing a Proposed Interim Solution by one week, until April 10, 2019.

9.

ENO has contacted the Parties seeking any objections to the request sought herein. As of the filing of this Motion, no party has objected to the relief requested and the Advisors have indicated they affirmatively support the relief requested.

WHEREFORE, Entergy New Orleans, LLC respectfully requests that its Unopposed Motion to Extend the Existing Procedural Schedule Deadlines be GRANTED and that the deadline for filing a proposed interim solution, set forth in Ordering Paragraph 6 of Council Resolution No. R-18-539 be extended until April 10, 2019.
