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

**ORDER**

On February 11, 2022, Entergy New Orleans, LLC (ENO) filed a Motion to Extend Deadline seeking to extend the deadline set forth in Council Resolution R-21-401 from March 1, 2022 to August 31, 2022. On February 16, 2022, Intervenors, Greater New Orleans Interfaith Climate Coalition (GNOICC) and the Alliance for Affordable Energy (the Alliance) jointly filed an opposition response. However, on February 17, 2022, ENO filed an Amended Motion to Extend Deadline, and recited therein that “ENO has consulted with its experts to determine whether anything can be done to accelerate its filing” and now seeks to extend said deadline only until July 1, 2022. While the original motion and joint response are now moot, because time is of the essence in light of the time constraints imposed under Council Resolution R-21-401, an expedited briefing period is required.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that any party opposed to the Amended Motion may file an opposition response by **February 23, 2022**, and ENO (and any other party in support of the Amended Motion) may file a reply to the opposition response by **February 28, 2022**.
