<u>ORDER</u>

Council Resolution R-22-142, provided that the Council Advisors ("Advisors") were to "report their findings in the form of a [Storm Reserve] written report ... on or before Friday, August 12, 2022" and further provided that the Hearing Officer "shall certify the record ... no later than Tuesday, August 30, 2022. *Id.*, Ordering paragraphs 9, 10. By Order dated August 10, 2022, the Hearing Officer granted the motion of Advisors to extend the deadline for filing the Advisors' Storm Reserve Report until August 19, 2022. However, the deadline for the Hearing Officer to certify the record was left undisturbed.

Accordingly, IT IS HERBY ORDERED, that the parties confer forthwith for the purpose of reaching agreement on the appropriate contents of the full administrative record to be reviewed by the Council during its deliberative process. Moreover, the Parties shall attempt to agree upon the final Administrative Record Chart and jointly file the final version (subject to revision and supplementation by the Hearing Officer) by close of business on **August 25, 2022**. Should the Parties be unable to resolve any disputes as to the final Administrative Record Chart,

the Parties shall file a brief setting forth with specificity the nature of the dispute, as soon as possible, but no later than August 25, 2022. The Hearing Officer requests the Advisors take the lead in circulating and filing the final version of the Administrative Record Chart drafted in general accordance with prior charts in prior dockets.
