**SUMMARY OF ENO’S RATE ADJUSTMENT SHOWN ON ATTACHMENT A TO THE SECURITIZED STORM COST RECOVERY RIDER II (“RIDER SSCRII”)**

Pursuant to the Financing Order adopted in Resolution R-22-437 (As Corrected) in Council Docket No. UD-22-01 (“Financing Order”), Entergy New Orleans, LLC (“ENO”) must file a Rate Adjustment shown in Attachment A to the Securitized Storm Cost Recovery Rider II (“Rider SSCRII”). Rider SSCRII is the mechanism through which ENO collects storm recovery charges on behalf of the Louisiana Utilities Restoration Corporation to pay the debt service obligations and other ongoing costs related to the storm recovery bonds, the issuance of which was authorized by the Council of the City of New Orleans (the “Council”) in the Financing Order in Council Docket No. UD-22-01.

The initial storm recovery charges will be implemented beginning on the first day of the first billing cycle of January 2023. ENO also will implement an offset rider (the Securitized Storm Cost Offset Rider (“Rider SSCOII”)) to address any adjustments or effects related to the financing and/or storm recovery process authorized in the Financing Order; however, ENO does not currently estimate any adjustments in the first year through Rider SSCOII. ENO’s initial storm recovery charges imposed on the monthly electric bill through Rider SSCRII for the bond issuance in the amount of \$209,300,000 authorized by the Council in the Financing Order are as follows:

**SECURITIZED STORM COST RECOVERY RIDER SSCRII**

---

**I. APPLICABILITY**

This rider is applicable under the regular terms and conditions of Entergy New Orleans, LLC to all customers served under any retail electric rate schedule\* and/or rider schedule\* or Special Contract Rates pursuant to Council of the City of New Orleans (the "Council") orders in Docket No. UD-22-01. The initial SSCRII rate shall be billed beginning on the first day of the first billing cycle of the next revenue month following the date of issuance of the storm recovery bonds.

**II. NET MONTHLY RATE**

There shall be added to each monthly bill an adjustment, in the form of a new and separate charge, for the replenishment of the storm recovery reserves and related financing costs as approved by the Council. Customer charges, energy charges, load or demand charges, lamp charges or access charges on any monthly bill shall be adjusted by the appropriate rate shown in Attachment A.

**III. TRUE-UP**

The SSCRII Rate Adjustment shall be subject to true-up in accordance with the schedule prescribed in the Council's financing order and shall be performed at least semi-annually.


