**UNOPPOSED MOTION OF ENTERGY NEW ORLEANS, INC.
FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THIRD AND FINAL STORM HARDENING REPORT
PURSUANT TO COUNCIL RESOLUTION R-15-31**

Entergy New Orleans, Inc. (“ENO” or “Company”) respectfully requests that the deadline for filing the third and final storm hardening report on ENO’s Post-Hurricane-Isaac Response and Storm Recovery Matters be extended from November 2, 2015 to January 21, 2016. This additional extension of time is being requested for two primary reasons: (1) Additional discussion is needed both internally at ENO and externally with the other parties to this docket prior to filing the final report to ensure that the final report provides the information regarding storm hardening that the Council is seeking, and it has been difficult to schedule and complete the necessary discussions due to the focus on, and expedited nature of, the Council’s proceeding regarding the Union Power Station transaction; and (2) To allow ENO to gather available information related to the electrical outages that occurred in ENO’s service area on Sunday, October 25, 2015, when the New Orleans area was hit by heavy rains and strong winds as the remnants of Hurricane Patricia passed over New Orleans to see if that information may inform the storm hardening issues to be addressed in the report. The Council Advisors and the Alliance

for Affordable Energy (the “Alliance”), the only intervenor in this docket, have been contacted and are not opposed to the requested extension.


The Council adopted Resolution R-15-31 on January 22, 2015, and therein established a schedule for ENO to report to the Council on certain storm hardening issues. That Resolution contained seven Ordering Paragraphs and each paragraph addressed different storm hardening issues and provided a timeline for reporting on those issues. In accordance with this schedule, on March 23, 2015, ENO filed its initial report addressing issues raised in Ordering Paragraphs 2, 6 and 7 of the Resolution. On May 22, 2015, ENO filed its second report addressing issues raised in Ordering Paragraphs 1, 4 and 5 of the Resolution. The third and final report, which will address issues raised in Ordering Paragraph 3, miscellaneous issues that arose during meetings with the Advisors and will tie the previous reports together, was originally due on July 21, 2015, but was extended first to August 31, 2015 and subsequently to November 2, 2015. On August 21, 2015, ENO filed a Supplemental and Amending Application in Council Docket No. UD-15-01, seeking Council authorization to purchase Power Block 1 of the Union Power Station located in Arkansas. That transaction involves a proposed quarter of a billion dollar investment and due to considerations relating to the timing of the closing of the transaction, ENO requested and the Council established an expedited procedural schedule. The magnitude and expedited nature of that proceeding has made it difficult to schedule and complete the discussions and work necessary to finalize the third report due in this docket. Accordingly, ENO is requesting an additional extension of this deadline until January 21, 2016, to allow it to work both internally within ENO and with the Council Advisors and the Alliance to address issues that have been raised during the course of the reporting period and to ensure, to the fullest extent possible, that the final report provides the information regarding storm hardening that the Council is seeking.

Additionally, as noted above, ENO would like to gather available information regarding the outages that occurred in the City on October 25, 2015 as a result of the heavy rains and high winds associated with the remnants of Hurricane Patricia to see if this outage information may inform the storm hardening issues being explored in this docket.

WHEREFORE, Entergy New Orleans, Inc. respectfully requests that the Honorable Jeffrey S. Gulin grant this Unopposed Motion and that the deadline for ENO to file the third and final storm hardening report, required pursuant to Council Resolution R-15-31 be extended from November 2, 2015 to January 21, 2016.


