The Alliance for Affordable Energy, ("the Alliance") respectfully requests that the Council of the City of New Orleans ("the Council") grant the Alliance the right to intervene in the above captioned proceeding and participate as a party therein.

On April 5, 2018, the full Council for the City of New Orleans issued Resolution R-18-100, establishing the above mentioned docket. It is customary for such Council resolutions to set a docket number and outline an intervention period, informing the public how and when to intervene. In this instance, there was no direction or intervention period described. However, Section 158-287 of the City's Code for Utility Regulation states, "Any party actually in interest may appear in any proceeding before the Council under this article."¹ The Code goes on to state, "...every civic, consumer, public advocacy and trade organization shall be permitted to appear in any proceeding whether as a formal intervenor or otherwise, and present any relevant and proper testimony and evidence bearing upon the issues involved in the particular proceeding."

The Alliance is a non-profit Louisiana organization that serves as a consumer advocate for the electric ratepayers of Louisiana, with special concern for residential and small commercial customers. The Alliance is dedicated to supporting fair, affordable, environmentally-responsible energy policy for the citizens of New Orleans and Louisiana.

The Alliance is a formal intervenor in other dockets considering electric infrastructure owned by Entergy New Orleans, LLC ("ENO").
