Audubon Louisiana, ("Audubon") respectfully requests that the Council of the City of New Orleans ("the Council") grant Audubon the right to intervene in the above captioned proceeding and participate as a party therein.

On March 28 2019, the full Council for the City of New Orleans voted to approve Resolution R19-109, establishing the above mentioned docket, providing for intervention by May 1, 2019.

Audubon is a 111 year old non-profit organization whose mission is to conserve and restore natural ecosystems, focusing on birds, other wildlife, and their habitats for the benefit of humanity and the earth's biological diversity. Audubon has used hundreds of thousands of citizen-science observations and sophisticated climate models to predict how birds in the U.S. and Canada are reacting to climate change. Our work defines the climate conditions birds need to survive, then maps where those conditions will be found in the future as the Earth's climate

responds to increased greenhouse gases. Audubon is dedicated to supporting climate and energy policies that will protect birds now and in the future.

Although Audubon has not been a formal intervenor in previous rulemaking dockets before this Council, it has formally intervened in numerous regulatory and administrative proceedings at the local, state and federal levels including utility rulemaking dockets in multiple jurisdictions.

Audubon has a local office and approximately 1,028 individual members served by Entergy New Orleans, LLC. There is no other party representing the interests of Audubon and its members.

Please note Audubon is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization thus pursuant to Council Resolution R-16-365, we request that all intervenor fees be waived.

In light of considerations above, Audubon therefore possesses standing to intervene, and respectfully seeks intervenor status in order to fully participate in this matter.
