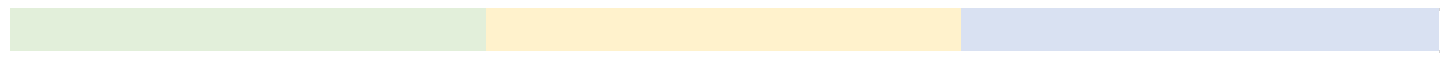

Small and Large Commercial Demand Response

- On July 24, 2019, ENO issued a Request for Proposals (RFPs) to solicit new implementers and programs for Small and Large Commercial Demand Response offerings.
- The Scope of the RFP included smart thermostats, load control switches and other curtailment measures for Small C&I. For Large C&I, building management control systems, motor or process control systems, and other curtailment measures were included.
- On August 21, 2019, ENO received responses from five respondents.
- ENO is presently in the process of evaluating these submissions and expects to make a selection during September, 2019.
- ENO intends to submit new, cost-effective offerings developed as a result of this RFP with its Implementation Plan to be filed by December 9, 2019.
- ENO will provide more detail in an upcoming interim Technical Conference in Oct./Nov. 2019.
