## **ORDER**

On June 9, 2022, an entity identifying itself as "Together New Orleans" filed a petition to intervene in the instant docket outside of the timeframe set forth in Council Resolution R-21-401, which had established November 29, 2021, as the deadline for petitioning for intervention. Any party that objects to said intervention shall file a written objection by June 20, 2022. If an objection *is* filed, Together New Orleans, and any party that supports the intervention, shall file a reply to the objection within 7 calendar days thereafter. If *no* timely objection is filed, the intervention shall be granted.
