

I.

ProRate is a Louisiana non-profit that promotes an electricity rate design to align the financial interests of all parties including ENO’s customer base, to reduce the price, cost, inequity of and unreliable access to electricity and the energy services electricity supplies by their investments in electrical solutions that support grid resilience, lower demand during crucial periods, facilitate load flexibility, energy efficiency, and reduced carbon dioxide emissions — while increasing ENO profitability.

Pursuant to Resolution R-21-401, adopted by the Council on October 27, 2021, the Council established a time-period ending on November 29, 2021, for intervention in the above referenced proceeding. ProRate has filed this request for intervention within that time-period. ProRate accepts the procedural posture of these proceedings.


III.


