## ORDER

Two contested motions, both filed by Crescent City Power Users' Group ("CCPUG") are pending before the Hearing Officer: Motion for Intervention filed on October 30; and Motion for Extension of Time to File Direct Testimony apparently filed on November 7, 2018.

Several parties have filed written support of both motions. However, on November 6, 2018, Entergy New Orleans, LLC ("ENO") filed an opposition to the motion for intervention (alternatively captioned as a motion to strike the intervention). Moreover, via email correspondence (*see* n. 1), the Advisors indicate that they intend to file an opposition to the motion for extension.

While it might be argued that briefing the motion for extension is premature prior to a ruling on the motion for intervention and opposition thereto, in the interest of time and efficiency, the Hearing Officer establishes the following briefing deadlines:

**November 14, 2018**: Any party may file a memorandum in support of, or in opposition to, either motion (or rest upon prior filings);

**November 21, 2018**: Any party may file a memorandum in rebuttal to any memorandum filed by November 14.
