<u>ORDER</u>

Council Resolution R-22-370 provides that the parties shall file "comments regarding ...

[Madison Energy Investment's] July 13, 2022 Motion to Amend the Community Solar Rules" by September 19, 2022. Resolution at Ordering Paragraph 1. On September 1, 2022, Madison Energy Investment ("Madison") filed a motion to extend the deadline until September 22, 2022, for filing responses to the First Set of Requests for Information directed to Madison by Entergy New Orleans, LLC, ("ENO"). On September 2, 2022, the undersigned Hearing Officer partially granted the motion by extending the deadline until 30 days after service of same. On September 7, 2022, ENO moved to extend the deadline for the parties to file comments to Madison's motion of July 13, 2022, "to a date 30 days following a 60-day period of discovery." Motion at 2. On September 8, 2022, the Hearing Officer set a deadline of September 10, 2022, for parties to file replies to the pending motion of ENO, and further provided that in the absence of any filed oppositions, the relief sought would be granted. No opposition replies were filed.

Accordingly, the procedural schedule as most recently modified under Council Resolution R-22-370 is hereby further modified as follow:

- 1. Discovery shall continue until November 7, 2022. Responses to discovery requests shall be due within 30 calendar days of receipt. Discovery requests must be timely served and received so that responses may be timely received by November 7, 2022. Objections to discovery requests must be asserted within 5 calendar days of receipt or deemed waived. However, as to discovery requests served prior to this Order, objections must be filed within 2 calendar days hereof or deemed waived.
- 2. Comments regarding Madison's July 13, 2022 Motion to Amend the Community Solar Rules" shall be filed by **December 7, 2022**.
