

**ORDER**

On July 25, 2024, the Council for the City of New Orleans issued Resolution R-24-310, establishing a procedural schedule for the limited purpose of addressing various issues in the instant docket, and therein set a deadline of August 16, 2024, for non-parties to file petitions to intervene. Resolution at Ordering paragraph 1, p. 6. On September 9, 2024, Carpe Diem Developers PR, LLC (“CDD”) filed an untimely petition to intervene.

In light of the Hearing Officer’s repeated admonitions respecting late filings, the Hearing Officer has occasionally dismissed such filings absent a showing of good cause with or without objection from other parties. However, given that the instant filing is only three weeks late, and because final Comments are not due until September 13, the Hearing Officer shall grant the petition, and CDD shall be added to the official service list. However, this shall be done in a manner so that no prejudice inures to any other party, *i.e.* the parties are under no obligation to extend accommodations to CDD respecting the already expired deadlines set forth in Resolution R-24-310. *See* Ordering paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6.
