## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER RESPECTING DISCOVERY

On September 2, 2025, Intervenors in the instant proceeding sent a letter to members of the New Orleans City Council alleging that Entergy New Orleans, LLC ("ENO") has been engaging in improper discovery practices in the instant proceeding.<sup>1</sup>
