**Petition of Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council for Intervention  
and Inclusion on Service List**

Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council respectfully requests that the Council of the City of New Orleans (“the Council”) grant Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council the right to intervene in the above captioned docket and participate as a party therein.

On August 10, 2017, the full Council for the City of New Orleans issued Resolution R-17-427, setting a procedural schedule for this docket, and setting a period of 15 days from the adoption of the Resolution for parties to file for intervention. This request is being made within the 15 day intervention period and is therefore timely.

Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council is a council of neighborhood associations and HOAs, representing residents residing (or working) in Orleans Parish.

Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council has residents (or businesses) served by ENO who have been affected by power outage disruptions. There is no other party representing the interests of Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council and its members.

Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council intends to participate in this proceeding in order to protect the interests of the residential and small commercial Entergy New Orleans, Inc. (“ENO”) customers.

Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council’s interests in this proceeding include,

a) Power Outages

b) Disruption of cable & phone service during power outages

c) Disruption of work of some residents who work at home.

Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council possesses standing to intervene in the aforementioned matter, and respectfully seeks full intervenor status in order to fully participate in this docket.

Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council requests that it be placed on the service list of this proceeding and be served with all pleadings, notices orders, and other filings.
