On August 10, 2017, the full Council for the City of New Orleans issued Resolution R-17-427, setting a procedural schedule for this docket, and setting a period of 15 days from the adoption of the Resolution for parties to file for intervention. This request is being made within the 15 day intervention period and is therefore timely.

Carrollton Riverbend Neighborhood Association is a non-profit/neighborhood association in Orleans Parish. The Association’s mission is to improve and promote the quality of life within the Carrollton Riverbend area.

Carrollton Riverbend Neighborhood Association has residents and businesses served by ENO who have been affected by power outage disruptions. There is no other party representing the interests of Carrollton Riverbend Neighborhood Association and its members.

Carrollton Riverbend Neighborhood Association intends to participate in this proceeding in order to protect the interests of the residential and small commercial Entergy New Orleans, Inc. (“ENO”) customers.

Carrollton Riverbend Neighborhood Association’s interests in this proceeding include,

- a) citizens wish to understand the source and reasons for power outages
- b) citizens wish to understand the strengths and weaknesses in our electrical distribution system

c) citizens wish to understand protective measures that will be taken to prevent power outages in the future

Carrollton Riverbend Neighborhood Association possesses standing to intervene in the aforementioned matter, and respectfully seeks full intervenor status in order to fully participate in this docket.

Carrollton Riverbend Neighborhood Association requests that it be placed on the service list of this proceeding and be served with all pleadings, notices orders, and other filings.
