

**Urban Conservancy Petition for Intervention

Urban Conservancy respectfully requests that the Council of the City of New Orleans (“the Council”) grant Urban Conservancy the right to intervene in the above captioned docket and participate as a party therein.

On August 10, 2017, the full Council for the City of New Orleans issued Resolution R-17-427, setting a procedural schedule for this docket, and setting a period of 15 days from the adoption of the Resolution for parties to file for intervention. This request is being made within the 15 day intervention period and is therefore timely.

Urban Conservancy is a non-profit organization, working in Orleans Parish to catalyze equitable practices and policies related to the urban built environment and local economy through research, education, and advocacy.

Urban Conservancy has residents and businesses served by ENO who have been affected by power outage disruptions. There is no other party representing the interests of Urban Conservancy and its members.

Urban Conservancy intends to participate in this proceeding in order to protect the interests of the residential and small commercial Entergy New Orleans, Inc. (“ENO”) customers.

Urban Conservancy’s interests in this proceeding include ensuring the wise stewardship of the

urban built environment and local economy, the effects of outages on water management by the City of New Orleans and residents, and the economic effects of outages on businesses in the New Orleans area.

Urban Conservancy possesses standing to intervene in the aforementioned matter, and respectfully seeks full intervenor status in order to fully participate in this docket.


Urban Conservancy requests that it be placed on the service list of this proceeding and be served with all pleadings, notices orders, and other filings.
