The American Institute of Architects Petition for Intervention and Inclusion on Service List

On December 14th, 2017, the full Council for the City of New Orleans issued Resolution R-17-622, establishing a procedural schedule for this docket and setting a deadline of intervention by January 26, 2017. This request is being made within the intervention period and is therefore timely.

The AIA is a non-profit member-driven professional association that advances the practice of architecture in New Orleans through a comprehensive program of professional development, professional peer engagement, advocacy, and public awareness activities.

The AIA is a formal intervenor in Council Dockets UD-17-03 concerning Entergy New Orleans, Inc ("ENO") resource additions. The AIA has members served by ENO. There is no other party representing the interests of the AIA and its members.

The AIA intends to participate in this proceeding in order to ensure a more susatainable built environment for all residential and commercial Entergy New Orleans, Inc. ("ENO") customers.

The AIA's interests in this proceeding include:

- a) Ensuring New Orleans rate-payers are served with the most cost-effective resources; and
- b) Increasing implementation of, and reliance on, energy use sensors, data and metrics; and
- c) Increasing access to clean, renewable energy in New Orleans; and

- d) Considerations related to improving and sustaining ENO system's reliability and resilience, including continued modernization of ENO's distribution system; and
- e) Efforts to coordinate the council's Resolutions R-17-303, to commit New Orleans to the Paris Climate Agreement, and R-17-428, to dramatically reduce greenhouse gas emissions with resource planning.
